MATH & LANGUAGE ARTS

Math:

This week we will use problem solving, mathematical communication, reasoning, connections & representations to investigate and identify the **place value** for each digit in a **six-digit** numeral. We will read six-digit numerals orally, and write six-digit numerals that are stated verbally or written in words. (3.1a).

Language Arts:

This week we will begin to read and demonstrate comprehension of nonfiction texts. We will preview and use text features (*headings, chapter layout, charts, graphs, pictures, photographs*). The table of contents, indices and charts will be discussed as a source of reference to locate information. SOL 3.6 / 3.7b

We will continue to use knowledge of roots and affixes when reading to determine the meaning of new words formed when a known affix is added to the known word (e.g., care/careless, heat/reheat) SOL3.4b
